Re: Follow Up from pleasant meeting February 18, 2019 in Toronto.

Thank you for your kind reception at your Levee it was a pleasure to meet you.
I was interested in your comment, that you have to follow international Law as per your role as Foreign Affairs Minister.
I was also please that you suggested that we should again meeting in March for formal discussions on our issues, please arrange to do so.

Just for point of clarification the points of discussion are as follows: The Submission of our Comprehensive Claim against the Corporations of Canada, under International Law, and the Directions of H.R.H the Queen for Treaty negotiations, pursuant to the UN Treaty Protocol, "simple signature".

Stressing the UNPRIP and the reaffirmation of the Royal Proclamation of 1763 within the Charter of Rights and Freedom 1981 and the Constitution of Canada 1982, requiring signature on treaty, with respect to our un-treated and un-ceded lands. The Daniel's vs. Canada 2016 discovered "us (Métis)" and stated that the Father's of Confederation intended to include our people under your classes of subjects wherein we had been excluded due to patriarchal gender subjugation of women lines "the bastard Canadiens". We find it interesting also, in time of political correctness, while the Constitution of Canada states "Métis" the judges renamed us Indians but not under the Indian Act. As far as us Métis believe, our name of Métis predated occupation of our land and is special, Indians however come from India.

Our other discussion points are the continued suppression of our people the "mud sill of Canadians", in all aspects of economic development. And the bull dozing and current intent to continue bull doze of our properties, that we had to repatriate and then are stolen again by the corporate governance of the Crown, in dishonour of the crown.

International law stated in summary of the UN lawyer, "if any colonial government has taken indigenous land in illegitimacy, the colonial government immediately has to repatriate those lands back to the indigenous people." This is also reflected in the UN policy for Decolonization of Colonies.

I trust we will have immediate meaningful discussions, resulting in treaty.
Go in a good way the grandmothers are watching.
