***RE: Failure to Invite Leaders of our Nation, for December 6<sup>th</sup> Montreal Meeting with Indigenous Leaders.***

Dear Cousin:

I believe its time your administrative staff should be capable to inform you, that you have a responsibility to meet with our Nation’s leaders. It appears that letters from Buckingham Palace and the Governor General of Canada as requested by HRM has yet to be presented to you, with respect to the obligation under international law (United Nation’s Treaty Process, simple signature) and the legal duty to undergo treaty process with our Nation pursuant to the Royal Proclamation as upheld in the Supreme Court Decision of April 14, 2016.

Since resigning as A/Senior Scientific Advisor, leaving INAC Ontario Region in 2004, both the former Conservative Corporate government and now the Liberal Corporate government have been and are in adversarial position with respect to our un-surrendered and un-ceded Nation. A meeting with the Minister of Foreign Affairs is required under UN simple signature. Our Nation has requested a meeting with the Minister, however no response.

Since I returned from the 2005-6 Great Lakes Water Quality meetings to update the GLWQA under the Boundary Water Act of 1906, the Corporate Government in power have refused to meet except for once, wherein the lawyers for INAC told us to take the government to court.

It appears the both the Conservative and Liberals only converse with surrendered Indian under the Indian Act and those political lobbyist groups corporations that you fund. Is this the reality? If not, I assume our leaders will be invited to the meeting and it was a clerical error. However, I must note we have outstanding requests to meet with the Prime Minister of Canada for 18 years.

I addressed you as cousin as per Indigenous Customs and Traditions as we share common grandfathers on the Trudeau lines.
