Re: Request for meeting on Constitutional Challenge, pursuant to Canada UNDRIP Act

Halu / Tanshi

It is with great respect I write to you, respecting our ASMIN Nations struggle for the last 17 years subsequent to the Powley Decision of the Supreme Court which took 14 years to reach a decision. The Daniel SC case took 34 years. These statements set the stage of our struggle with the Federal and Provincial Governments.

As Former A/ Senior Scientific Advisor to Indian Affairs Ontario Region, sitting on The Great Lake Water Quality Agreement Treaty Negotiation Team (2005-6) as a Chief of our Nation, upon returning home the Federal Government and the Provincial governments place themselves in adversarial positioning.

In 2005 I was invited to meet with the former Governor General the Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean, to discuss Indigenous Affairs. She instructed me to meet again once it was appropriate to advance our indigenous rights pursuant to the Constitution. However, timing has not been appropriate until Canada signed into effect the Canada UNRIP Act June 21 2021.

It is important to note that our Nation filed to all the Provinces, Territories and the Federal Government, the United Nations and to Her Royal Majesty the Queen, our comprehensive claim February 11 2009. We refiled under simple signature (UN Treaty Protocol) with our Name Change to ASMIN Prior to the Liberal election of Mr. Trudeau (post Daniel's SCC Decision).

The Queen responded within 13 days, Canada has yet to respond and refuses to meet with our Nation.
